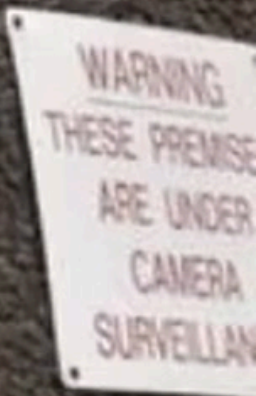
Use red dough to create a small fire. Role-play rescuing people or animals from the fire.
