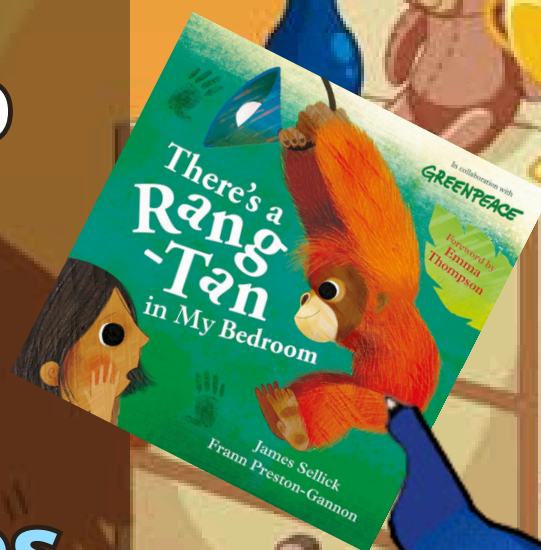
QUESTION: How does playing help, my child learn language?
