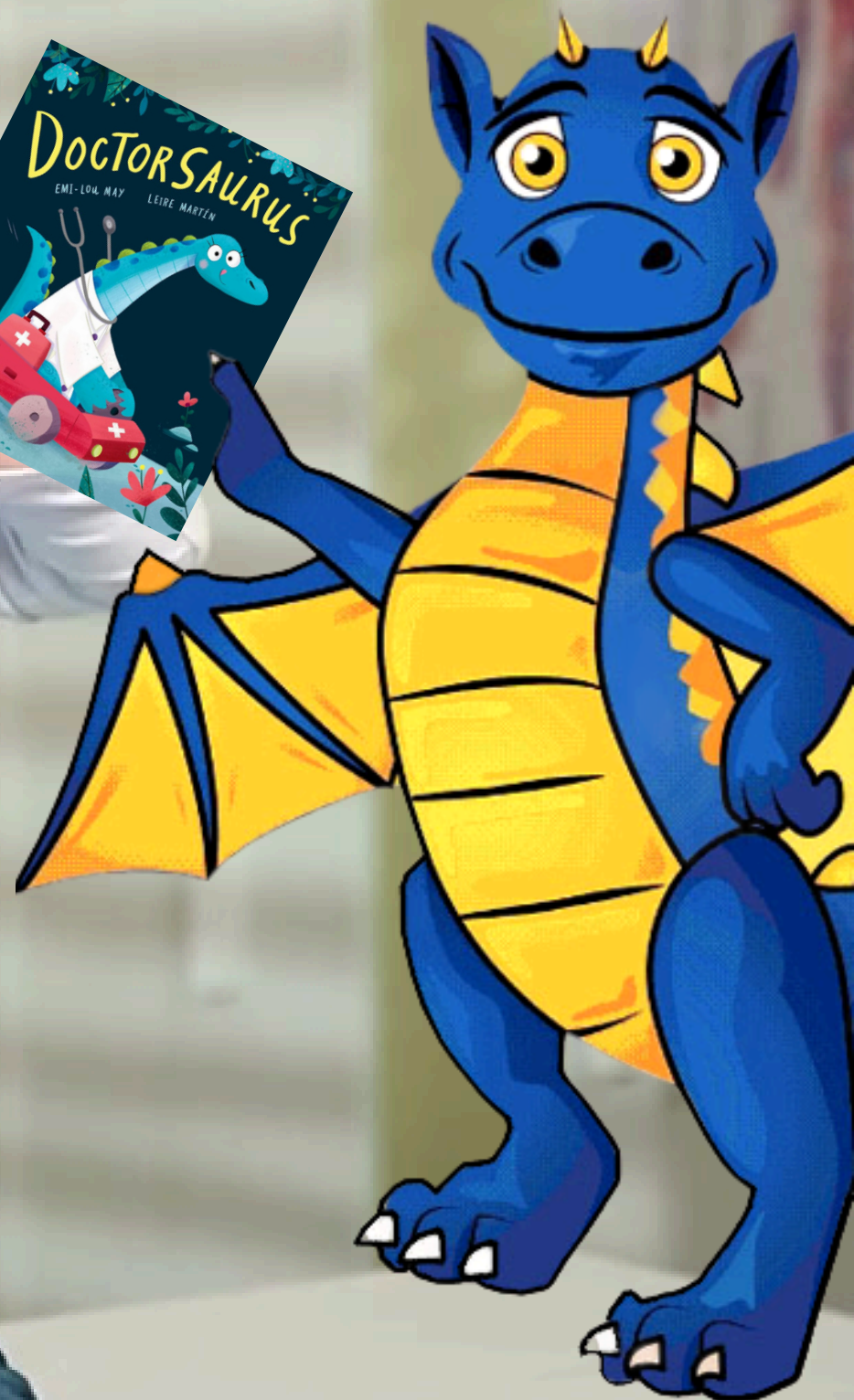
What kind of questions should I ask my child after reading a story.
