How to Enrol



Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for funding on our courses, you should meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Aged 19 years old or older on 31st August 2026 AND
- ✓ Be a resident in London AND
- ✓ Have valid permission to live in the UK for at least 12 months on the first day of learning.

AND

- ✓ Be a UK/Irish National OR
- ✓ Have settled or pre-settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme

OR

- ✓ Have permission granted by the UK Government to live in the UK, and such permission is not for educational purposes only.

Others with certain types of immigration status and their family members, may be eligible (including refugees and asylum seekers) – **please contact us at AdultEducation@cityoflondon.gov.uk**

Some accredited courses may be free if you meet the eligibility criteria, but this will depend on the previous qualifications you have achieved and/or if you have an income below the threshold of the London Living Wage (£28,860.25) – subject to change during the academic year).

Digital Hub Legacy Continuing the Mission

The Mayor of London's Skills Academies Digital Hub Programme played a key role in supporting Londoners most affected by the pandemic, helping them move into sustainable employment in sectors critical to the city's recovery and future growth.

Following the conclusion of this programme in April 2024, the City of London Corporation has continued this important work, ensuring that learners still have access to high-quality digital training and clear routes into employment.

A central focus of this work is to reduce employment gaps and support individuals who are unemployed, under-represented, or facing barriers to entering the workforce.

Supported Internships & Employer Forum (SEND)

What is a Supported Internship?

Supported internships is a programme designed to provide young people with learning disabilities or difficulties, aged 16-24, with the opportunity to gain valuable work experience and develop skills in a real work environment. The programme is supported by the government and is aimed at helping young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) into employment.

How do they work?

The City of London Corporation's supported internship programme is delivered in a way that best suits the needs of the young people. We will aim to work with a few different external organisations and employers to provide work placements that are tailored to the needs of each individual intern. During the internship, participants receive training and support from a job coach or mentor, who works with them to develop their skills and help them achieve their goals.

The programme usually lasts for a year and can include a combination of work placement and college-based learning. It is designed to help young people develop practical skills that are transferable to other job roles such as maths, English and IT, as well as the confidence and independence needed to succeed in the workplace.

Who benefits?

Supported internships can benefit the interns and the employers. For the interns, the programme provides an opportunity to gain valuable work experience, develop new skills, and build their confidence. For employers, it offers the chance to work with talented and motivated young people who can bring fresh perspectives and ideas to their organisation. Overall, supported internships are a valuable way to help young people with special educational needs make the transition to employment and build successful careers.

We provide a strong Information, Advice and Guidance (IAG) service to support apprentices throughout their journey – from securing a role to progressing in their career, whether within the City of London Corporation or beyond.

Earn While You Learn

As an apprentice, you will be employed in a real job while working towards a recognised qualification.

Our programmes are designed to help you develop the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed for your chosen career. Apprenticeships typically take 18 to 36 months to complete, depending on the programme.

Delivery may include a mix of:

- ✓ face-to-face learning
- ✓ online sessions
- ✓ workplace-based training.

Functional Skills (English and Maths)

Some apprenticeships require you to achieve English and maths qualifications:

- ✓ Level 1 for Intermediate apprenticeships
- ✓ Level 2 for Advanced and Higher apprenticeships

If you are under 18 and do not already have GCSE English or maths at Grade 4 (C) or above, you will be required to complete Functional Skills as part of your programme.

For learners aged 19 and over, Functional Skills may not be required unless specified within the apprenticeship standard. Where needed, full support will be provided to help you achieve these qualifications.

End Point Assessment (EPA)

At the end of your apprenticeship, you will complete an End Point Assessment (EPA). This is carried out by an independent assessor and evaluates your competence against the apprenticeship standard.

- ✓ Merit
- ✓ Distinction
