9:30AM: INTRODUCTION TO PREVENT IN HACKNEY - TRACEY THOMAS  
Learn about the Prevent Duty, how Prevent is delivered in Hackney and who the Prevent Team are.


10:15AM: PREVENT COUNTER TERRORISM POLICE - PS JAMES WALSH  
Understand the role of SO15 Police in the Prevent space, the Prevent referral process and thresholds for escalation.

11:15AM: ISLAMIST EXTREMISM - GHAFFAR HUSSAIN  
An overview on the rise and history of the Islamist Extremism ideology, the extremist narratives utilised and associated groups.

4PM: INCEL IDEOLOGY- MADELEINE STREET 
Examine incel ideology and the rise of misogynistic influencers such as Andrew Tate. Understand associated vulnerabilities and how to support.

5PM: COUNTERING FAR RIGHT EXTREMISM - SMALL STEPS 
Delivered by former far right members, the workshop is designed to help spot far-right activity, recognise signs of radicalisation and give advice on how to intervene safely.

Activist Payzee Mahmud shares her story of escaping child marriage and how she turned her childhood trauma into positive activism.

 **12PM: HACKNEY'S INTEGRATED GANGS UNIT**
A presentation from Hackney's IGU on the borough's gang violence, influencing factors and intervention work being done.

 **2PM: TACKLING YOUTH VIOLENCE - MINUS VIOLENCE**
Understand the factors that influence youth violence. Explore prevention, diversion and gain credible tools for intervention.
