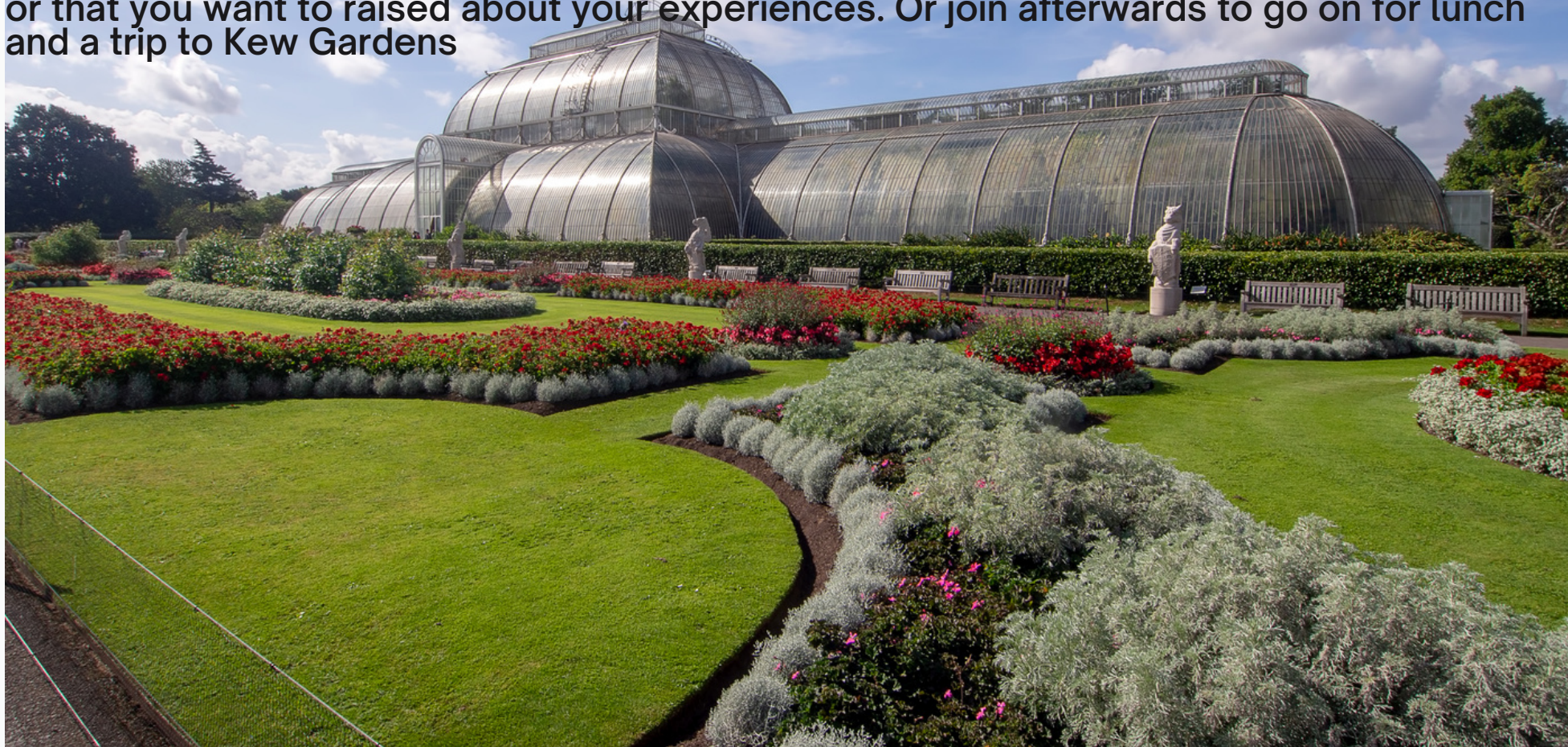
CiCC Meeting & Activity
